Welcome to the 2009 School Sport Australia Triathlon Championships. Below are a few details to start planning for the championships.

Venue: The Bluff
Devonport
Tasmania

Dates: **Friday 20th March Arrival**

After arriving in Launceston teams will proceed to the accommodation venue at Camp Clayton. Teams are responsible for their own team transport. Transport contacts are listed below. The LOC will transport all bikes to the transition area at the Bluff in Devonport. The bikes will be placed in secure storage on site. Teams may choose to assemble bikes during the late afternoon. However please note that the bikes will not be in Devonport until about two hours after the arrival of the last team in Launceston.

Saturday 21st March Opening Ceremony 11.00 – 12.00am

The opening Ceremony will take place at the Devonport High starting at 11.00am (Draft). More details will be provided later

The team photographs will be taken at the Devonport High immediately after the Opening Ceremony

Athletes will be able to familiarise themselves with the course during this time. The bike course will be closed to traffic between 3.00pm and 4.00pm. The swim course will be supervised.

Bike Land Transport:

As noted above the LOC will take responsibility of transporting all bikes from Launceston to Devonport and return upon request from states. This will incur an extra cost. The bikes will be taken directly from the Launceston airport to the transition area at the Bluff where they will be stored for the championship. Teams will be met at the Launceston airport by a LOC official who will take charge of the bikes if required. Please be sure all bike boxes are well labelled.

Officials & Students Accommodation:

Teams and their officials will be accommodated at Camp Clayton. The accommodation is situated approximately 10km from the course start/finish in Devonport.
